

What is my vision like with cataracts? Cataracts are a clouding of the natural lens in your eye which may cause trouble driving at night, or hazy “film” like vision. If you are experiencing any of the symptoms below it might be time for you to be evaluated for cataract surgery. If you have cataracts you may have the following vision problems:

- Things do not look clear and bright
- Colors appear dull or objects seem yellowed
- Your Vision is blurry or dim
- Seeing glare and halos while driving at night




Laser Cataract Surgery

At TOC EYE our surgeons specialize in both Cataract and Refractive cataract surgery.

Cataracts start to develop in our 40's and slowly progress often without our notice. Signs of Cataract progression are trouble driving at night, especially in the rain, glare and halos around lights, decreased reading vision, and a decrease in brightness of colors. If you are experiencing any of these symptoms it might be time for you to be evaluated for cataract surgery. Even patients who have mild cataracts, without symptoms may be eligible for laser cataract surgery, which is done when patients wish to be free of glasses. With advances in today's technology our surgeons have the ability to eliminate your dependence on glasses for distance AND near with the use of special lenses called Multi-Focal and Astigmatic correcting lenses.
